Executive Director Report Operations Update

Paige Hargrove, LERN Executive Director, updated the Board on LERN's three year plan through CY 2022, attached here as <u>Attachment B</u>. Ms. Hargrove acknowledged that LERN has met almost 90% of the goals set forth therein. No formal action was taken by the Board.

LERN Move Update

Paige Hargrove, LERN Executive Director, advised that the LERN office is scheduled to move to the new location in May of 2023. No formal action was taken by the Board.

Peds Ready Facility Recognition

William Freeman, M.D., presented "Pediatric Ready Emergency Department Program" to the Board. This program is facilitated by EMS for Children (EMS-C) with the goal of ensuring that every Emergency Department has the equipment, supplies, medications, and training to provide high quality emergency care for children. The Advisory Board has worked with hospitals statewide to develop two levels – Peds Ready and Advanced Peds Ready. See <u>Attachment C</u>. Dr. Freeman asked for Board support and endorsement the ED Facility Recognition Program. A motion was made by Ms. Sutton and seconded by Mr. Walker to endorse the "EMS-C Pediatric Ready Emergency Department Program" and requirements in the "Facility Guide". The motion was approved after a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

Trauma Update 2023 Strategic Goals

Paige Hargrove reminded the group, that the board is in the second year of a three-year strategic plan. Each year, the medical directors present new goals to advance the strategic priorities.

Michael Sutherland, MD, LERN Trauma Medical Director, presented the LERN 2023 Strategic Goals related to the Trauma system in Louisiana. See <u>Attachment D</u>, p. 1. A motion was made by Scott Guidry and seconded by Dr. John Jones to approve the Strategic Goals for Trauma in Louisiana for calendar year 2023.

Our Lady of Lourdes (ABA)

Dr. Sutherland informed the Board, Our Lady of Lourdes received burn center verification from the American Burn Association (ABA). This is the second ABA verified burn center in Louisiana. The other is University Medical Center New Orleans.

Stroke Update 2023 Strategic Goals

Dr. Martin-Schild, LERN Stroke Medical Director, presented the 2023 Strategic Goals related to Stroke in Louisiana. See <u>Attachment D</u>, p. 1 attached. A motion was made by Ms. Wyble and seconded by Dr. Zweifler to approve the Strategic Goals for Stroke in Louisiana. The motion was approved after a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

STEMI Update

Paige Hargrove, LERN Executive Director, presented 2023 STEMI goals related activities in Louisiana. See <u>Attachment D</u>, p. 2. A motion was made by Dr. Kanter and seconded by Mr. Morse to accept the 2023 Strategic Goals regarding STEMI. The motion was approved after a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

In addition, discussion ensued regarding CPR and the desire to have a person certified in CPR present at all LHSAA sporting events. The Board requested that the LERN attorney to research current CPR legislation and to report back at the May board meeting.

BURN System

Executive Director Hargrove presented the 2023 Burn System Goals. See <u>Attachment D</u>, p. 2. A motion was made by Ms. Sutton and seconded by Dr. Hunt to accept the LERN 2023 Strategic Goals regarding the Burn System. The motion was approved after a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

Ms. Hargrove presented goals related to strategic priorities Nos. 3 and 4. A motion was made by Dr. Jacome and seconded by Dr. Freeman to accept Strategic Priority Nos. 3 and 4. See <u>Attachment D</u>. The motion was approved after a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

2022 LCC Data Report

Chris Hector, LERN Administrative Director, presented the "LERN Communication Center 2022 Patient Data" report. See <u>Attachment E</u>. No formal action was taken by the board.

Budget

Dr. Freeman, Treasurer, provided the Board with an overview of the fiscal year 2022 budget as of January 25, 2023. See <u>Attachment F</u>. No formal action was taken by the board.

Ms. Hargrove thanked the Communications Center for their continuing diligence and hard work.

The executive director thanked everyone for attending the Board meeting. She then recognized Mr. Scott Guidry fort his service to the board, both as a member of the Executive Committee and an active member of the board. Mr. Guidry resigned from the Board effective 2/17/2023.
